

Reference: Designate - A - Bin Program

Hello DARE Instructors,

You are back in your school and I am sure you are trying to get to the bottom of your emails. I am going to attempt to give you reasoning behind the plan for Designate a Bin.

I am comparing it to a money making Certificates of Deposit (CD's) investment ladder.

The Designate a Bin program spreads your money receiving ability over the years so that as you use the available money from one bin the first year while the other bins are gaining reserve money for your next years DARE program. (Bin must be in service a full year to collect = 12 months)

Designate a Bin program

I will designate (give) you 2 bins which equals instance cash \$200.00 (\$100.00 each)

You will secure **2 locations** where bins can be placed. A bin will take up approximately one parking space. Some locations are large enough to hold 2 bins on that one site which means more money for your program per site that you secure...

Look for high visibility and easy access by the public. Ask the owner of the location if they would allow the bins to be placed on their property which helps you with purchasing DARE workbooks etc. keeping DARE in the schools. (NOTE: No longer putting bins on school property)

Dawn Holtsclaw with Mid Atlantic Clothing Recycling (MAC) will come to the location and talk with the owner if needed to help secure the site or explain and address any concerns the owner may have about MAC.

Consider this:

Officer Werner upon completing DOT in June 2010 went back to her area and started working this program. If you look at the "Orig. DATE" you see the bin she requested as her designated bin(s) was place on site 11-01-08 which means she has 2 (see # of bins) on this one site that she can collect money for her program for this 2010-2011 school year.

The bin that Officer Werner **Established** on Elmwood in July will give her money next year if it remains on site and collects clothing for a year (12 months). Officer Werner is attempting to secure the other locations for her schools (**pending**) which will give her more available money in 2011-12 for her schools to buy DARE supplies. Unless she is successful in establishing another location for the school year 2011-12 she will only have the \$100.00 that is secure at 1027 Elmwood for next year. The following school year 2012-13, she will have money coming in from the year of collecting back at the 421 Bush River Rd location. Meaning with the Bush River location having 2 bins on that one location, she has in the bank \$100.00 per bin equaling to a total of \$200.00 for 2012-13 school year.

I hope this method inspires you to look around your area for a bin. Send me an email requesting that a bin on location be **Designated** to your school(s) (give me the address where the bin(s) is located). Then use the letter that I sent you to ask owners of other locations to allow a bin to be placed on their property. If the owner approves fill out the form and send it as a fax to Dawn Holtsclaw at 864-578-1212 as well a fax to me at 803-419-4816. The action of placing the bin on the location will now be taken over by Dawn.
